



What is LASIK?



LASIK is a procedure that improves vision by reshaping the cornea, enabling light to be properly focused onto the retina. While LASIK has improved the sight of millions, not everyone is a candidate.



Over 600,000 people get LASIK each year.

RLE: (Refractive Lens Exchange)
Refractive Lens Exchange is an option for people over the age of 45 who are near or farsighted. Similar to cataract surgery, the natural lens is removed and replaced with one of TLC's Premium Lens Options.



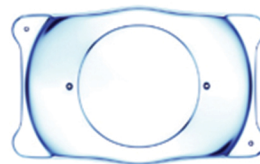

Visian ICL (Implantable Contact Lens)
Visian ICL is a LASIK alternative for people who are extremely nearsighted or have corneas that are too thin for LASIK.



A small, soft, flexible lens placed placed between the iris and natural lens.

The unique material provides UV protection while visible light passes through unaltered.
